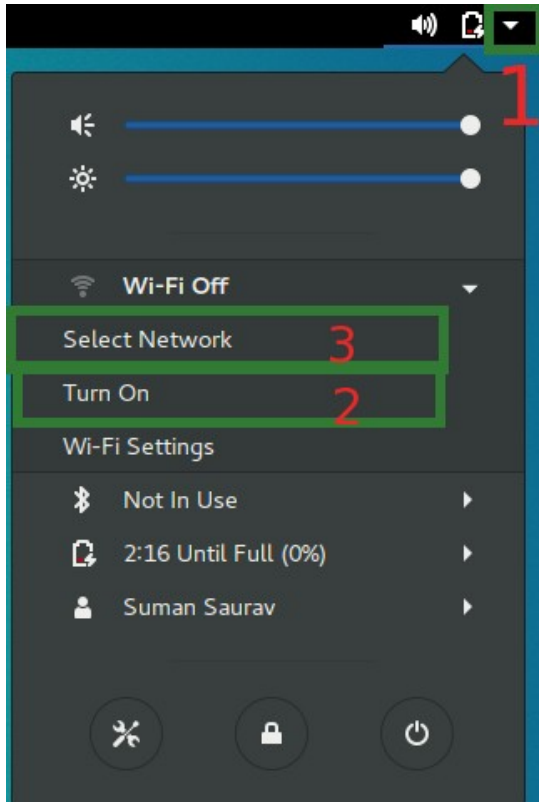
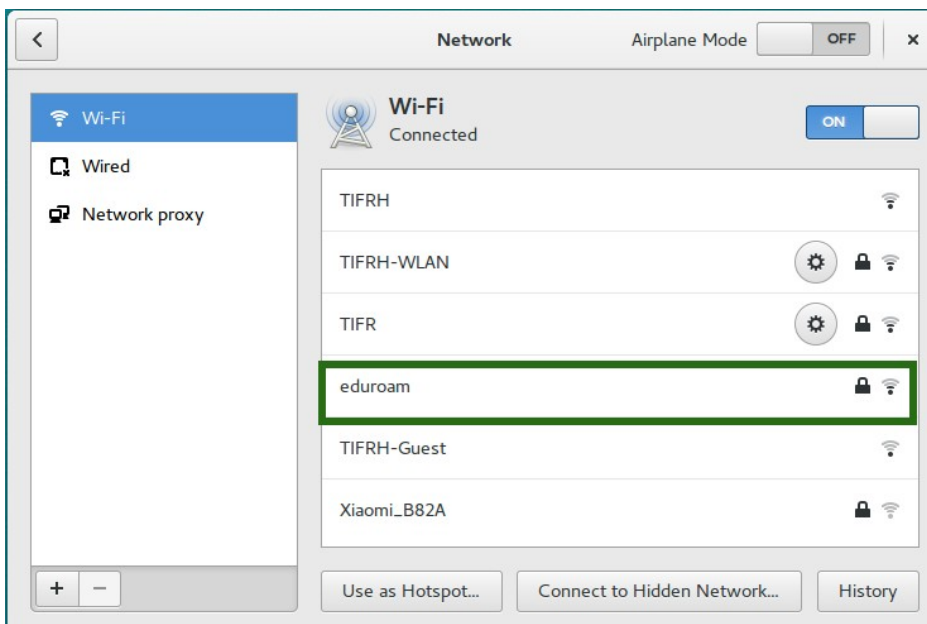


UBUNTU Setup for “eduroam”

1. Select drop-down menu from top-right corner, Turn on the wifi then click on select network



2. Select eduroam



3. Select the following:

Wi-Fi Security : WPA & WPA2 Enterprise

Authentication: Protected EAP (PEAP)

Anonymous identity : Enter username

CA certificate : None (Select No CA Certificate is required)

PEAP version : Automatic

Inner authentication MSCHAPv2

Then, enter username and password. Eg. Username : suman@tifrh.res.in
