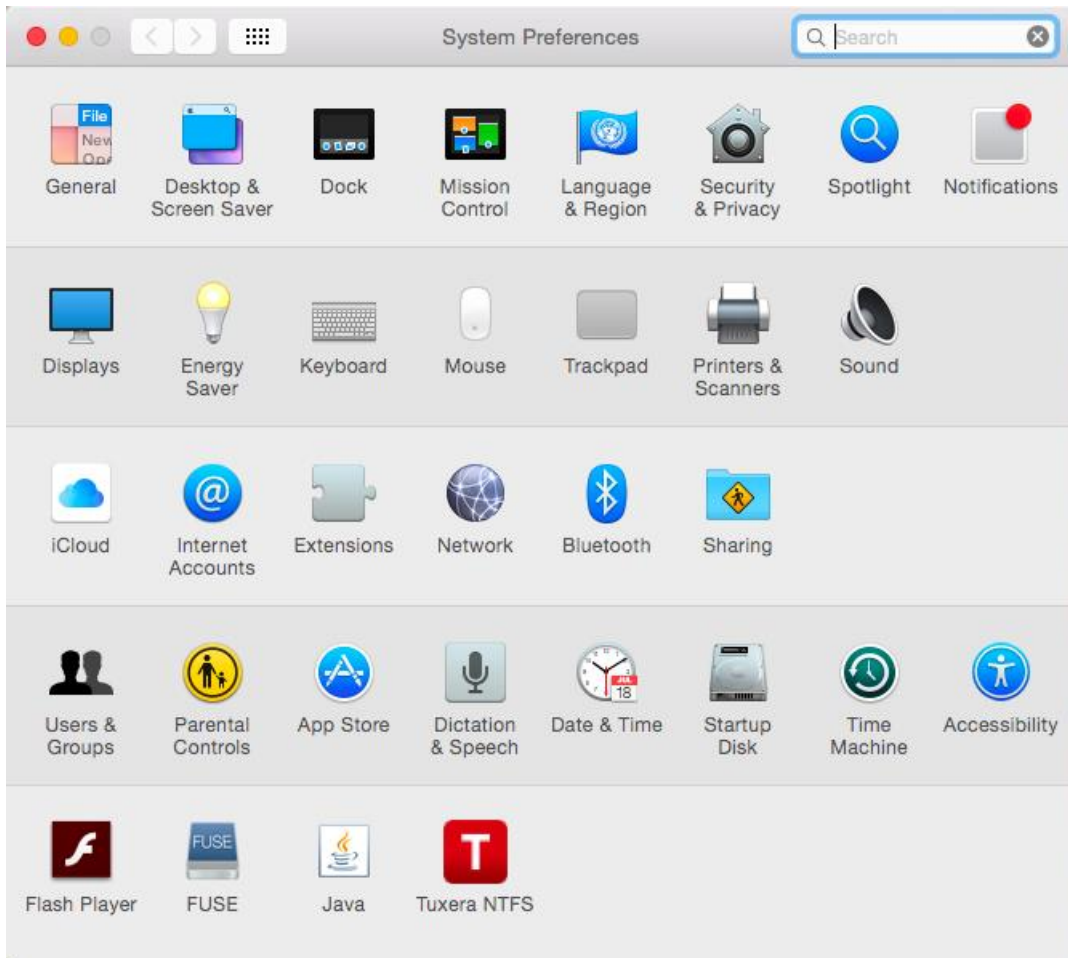
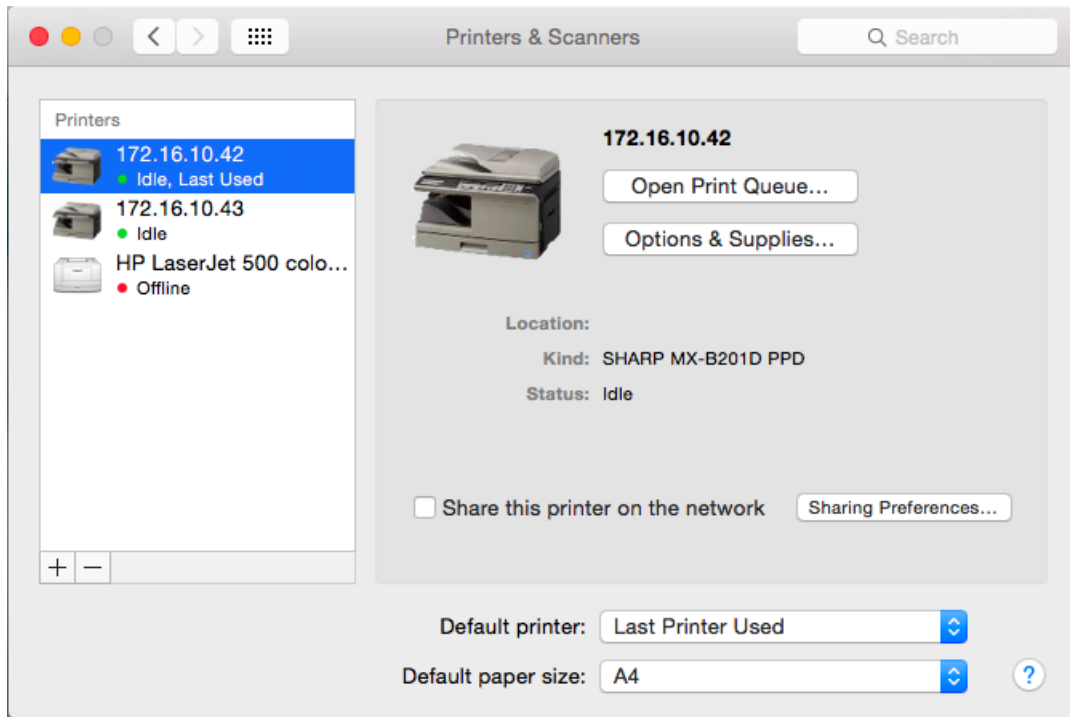


Printer Configuration in Mac

1. Select “System Preferences” and “Printers & Scanners”



2. Select “+” to add printer



3. Select IP tab and add printer IP address
