The discovery of the Higgs Boson and consequences: On the 2013 Physics Nobel Prize work of Englert and Higgs

The 2013 Nobel Prize has been jointly awarded to Francois Englert and Peter Higgs for their discovery of the Brout-Englert-Higgs mechanism as well as the prediction of the existence of the Higgs boson whose existence was confirmed at the CERN LHC experiment in 2013. In this work, we will review the basics of the mechanism and also describe the experiments from an elementary stand point and discuss some consequences.
